DETAILS: During a DWI stop on January 1st, 2012 police violently assaulted a woman for informing a friend about her right to refuse a sobriety test. A bystander who saw the violence (and captured it on film) was then also assaulted and arrested on trumped-up charges. The entire incident was caught on video and shows the officers' version of the events is untrue. Recently, police corporal Hippolito stated to Keye news that he did not see evidence on the dash-cam video of Antonio spitting on the officer.

This is a Rally to protest the APD for adding additional charges to the female victim and withholding the dash-cam video that would further exonerate Antonio of the felony charge.
